- Academically ranked in the top 10% of their class at the end of junior year.
- Able to complete a minimum of six full semesters at Norwalk High School by the time of graduation in June 2018.

- Do not change the font or the font size.
- The formatted word documents may not be scanned and then used for submission.
- All application information must be printed on single sided letter size paper.
- Do not fold either the application or the personal history.
