Today marks the 27th anniversary of Kevin's passing. It does not feel like it has been that long since Kevin's spirit and memory remain so ever present because of his life and the faithful generosity of the communities he touched. This generosity has allowed us to celebrate Kevin's life and perpetuate his legacy in the hearts and minds of the exceptional young men and women who are recipients of his scholarships. With the Fund's 2024 scholarship commitments we have, on behalf of our donors, awarded almost \$2.9 million in gifts of education to over 235 recipients in Kevin's memory.

On Saturday, April 6, 2024 Kevin's Fund will host its annual scholarship presentation and dinner dance to benefit Kevin's Scholarship Fund. The evening will be highlighted by the presentation of the 28th annual Kevin M. Eidt Memorial Scholarship to the most outstanding senior in the Norwalk High School class of 2024 in the amount of \$120,000.

The black-tie optional scholarship presentation and benefit dinner dance will be held at The Inn at Longshore in Westport, CT. The evening will commence at 6:30pm with entertainment, silent auction, and cash bar cocktail hour, followed by served dinner and dancing to the music of the Destiny Band. The cost of each ticket is \$150 of which \$70 represents a tax-deductible charitable contribution.
