

We are so forever grateful we were able to host this event tonight, fearful having to cancel for a second year in a row might hinder our ability to continue the Fund itself.

Tonight, we announce the 25th recipient of Kevin's Norwalk High School Scholarship. This Scholarship and the Fund that supports it, was created during the darkest of times. When we received the first donation, we had no idea a caring community would create, grow, and sustain something so remarkable. The first scholarship, awarded just six months after Kevin's death, was in the amount of \$2,500, but it was the beginning of something no one could have imagined. With tonight's presentation, the 25 scholarships awarded to the most outstanding senior in Norwalk High School totals \$1,675,000, including 16 consecutive years of awards of at least \$100,000.

On the following pages we celebrate 23 of these recipients. The celebration is for their lives, forever shaped by each supporter of Kevin's Fund as Kevin's spirit and legacy live on through them. For what they have given in return to everyone, especially those fortunate enough to know or have met Kevin, is best said in words from a song from <u>Hamilton</u>. "When you are gone, who remembers your name, who keeps your flame, who tells your story?"

These men and woman are the "who". They are mothers and fathers, artists, doctors and nurses, engineers, financial directors, lawyers, teachers, recruiters, start-up participants, and small business owners. As a donor, you have every right to take pride in their success, as this also reflects your success.

Everything began somewhere, required someone to have the passion to start it and pass it on to those with the passion to preserve it. Those messengers entrusted with preserving Kevin's scholarship, spirit, and legacy follow.
