Recommendation Categories

Academics: - From a teacher of a full credit junior or senior year course able to assess the applicant's commitment to academic achievement and performance. Multiple recommendations from the same teacher without a clear indication to the reader who the writer feels is the more accomplished applicant will not be considered.

<u>Athletics:</u> - From an athletic coach, manager, or mentor able to evaluate the applicant's athletic skills, commitment, spirit, sportsmanship, and teamwork.

<u>Arts:</u> - From a teacher or instructor of the arts able to evaluate the applicant's talent, dedication, and commitment.

<u>Community Service:</u> - From a supervisor, manager, or mentor of a community activity able to attest to and evaluate the nature and extent of the applicant's community service. Those writing a community service recommendation are requested to complete the recommendation writer evaluation sheet provided by the applicant. Recommendations from a for-profit organization does not qualify under our definition of Community Service.

<u>Religious Community:</u> - From a member of a religious community able to evaluate the applicant's involvement and participation in their activities. Those writing a religious community recommendation are requested to complete the recommendation writer evaluation sheet provided by the applicant.
